Article I

The name of this club will be Santa Barbara City College Climbing Club

Article 2

To promote and foster the climbing community within Santa Barbara City College. To teach ethical climbing practices and grow the skills of members of the club.

Article 3

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IV

Membership is open to all SBCC students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

ARTICLE V

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC-217.

ARTICLE VI

President 1– Preside over all meetings with their Co-President. Call special meetings.

President 2 – Preside over all meetings with their Co-President. Call special meetings.

Secretary – Records minutes of club meetings.

Treasurer – Keeps financial record.

Article VII

Presidents will be elected each year and serve for two semesters. All other officer positions will be appointed by the Presidents each semester.

Article VIII

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 60% of the Club members
