Arrive Dressed for Commencement 2:30 p.m. - Parking Lot 2B, Sports Pavilion

Because the ceremony will be held on the football field, please be conscious of the terrain. Graduates must wear flats or wedge-type shoes. We suggest that purses and personal belongings be left with family members.

Commencement Ceremony 4:00 p.m. - La Playa Stadium

In planning the evening's activities, allow 2 hours for the event. No reservations or invitations are needed for guests as they will sit in the stadium bleachers. You are asked to stay for the entire ceremony. You have earned this day. Enjoy it!

Graduating with Honors/Gold Tassel

Students earning an Associate degree with a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or higher (SBCC grades only) will receive a gold tassel at the line up for procession. Summer 2025 graduates will be eligible for gold tassels <u>after</u> summer grades are posted.

If your cumulative GPA as of Fall 2024 was <u>below</u> 3.5 but you believe your Spring 2025 grades will raise your cumulative GPA to 3.5 or higher, email written verification of **each final Spring grade with an instructor's signature to Candee Gyll, gyllc@sbcc.edu, no later than Wednesday, May 21, 2025** by 4:00 p.m. for a manual calculation of your GPA.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to RSVP that I will be participating in Commencement?

No, but you need to have an application for a degree or certificate on file by the deadline to have your name to appear in the Commencement program. DEADLINE FOR DEGREE APPLICATION IS WEDNESDAY APRIL 30, 2025.

Check your unofficial transcript in MySBCC for your application status. See <u>https://sbcc.edu/counselingcenter/degree_application.php</u> for application information.

"To confirm the status of your degree, check your unofficial transcript in MySBCC. If you already earned a degree, it will state "Awarded." It will state "Pending" if your application has been received and is still in progress."

Whose names appear in the Commencement Program?

Students who submitted their application for degrees or certificates for Summer 2024, Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 by the deadline will appear on the electronic program.

Am I allowed to sit with my graduating friends during the ceremony? Yes. You will be lining up in two lines for the Procession onto the field. Stay in the same line to be seated together.

Will my name be announced during the ceremony? Yes. You will complete a card that you will give to the announcer as you approach the platform at the ceremony. The announcer will read your name as you cross the platform.

Is there a limit to the number of guests invited to Graduation? No limit is set, but we would advise you to be mindful of the parking limitations on campus. Please consider carpooling. We encourage you to arrive early.

What accommodations are there for disabled person access? Early arrival is helpful. There are disabled person parking spaces located throughout the campus lots. The top of the stadium (Lot 1B) will be reserved and has wheelchair access. Check with Security at the kiosk as you enter the Main Campus.

Where should guests and graduates park? Most parking lots on campus are available to students, their families, and guests. Please arrive early as parking is on a first-come first- served basis. We recommend using West Campus parking lots.

If I will graduate Summer 2025 may I participate in the May 23rd ceremonies? Yes, you are welcome to participate. Your name will be announced. Please note: that your name will not appear on the Graduation list appearing on the scoreboard.

When will diplomas and certificates be available?

Diplomas will <u>not</u> be presented at Commencement. Effective Fall 2021, Parchment assumed responsibility for printing and mailing diplomas. You will be notified by MySBCC email when paper and digital diplomas are available. Please keep your mailing address up-to-date in MySBCC.

Unless otherwise notified, diplomas will be available by the following:

- Summer graduates: October
- Fall graduates: March
- Spring graduates: September

If I graduate with a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or higher in my SBCC classes, is this noted on my diploma? Yes. Diplomas for students earning Associate degrees with a 3.5 or higher will say "*With Honors*".

I have older diplomas on file with Admissions & Records. May I have them mailed to me?

Yes. The Diploma Mailing Request form is available online at <u>http://www.sbcc.edu/diplomas</u>. Diplomas issued for terms earlier than Fall 2021 may also be picked up at Admissions & Records (SS-110)
